### **Fundraising and Communication Trustee**

Tinnitus UK's vision is 'A world where no one suffers from tinnitus'.

We seek to achieve this through commissioning world-leading research and supporting people to live well with tinnitus. We are the only national charity in the UK solely dedicated to supporting the tinnitus community. One in seven adults in the UK have tinnitus and it is our aim to find a cure. We are the primary source of support and information for people with tinnitus in the UK, facilitating an improved quality of life. We provide a helpline to support tinnitus sufferers and we aim to encourage prevention through our educational programme.

Tinnitus UK is seeking a new Fundraising Trustee who has experience in all aspects of fundraising, partnerships and a strong communications background. We welcome candidates wishing to gain their first experience as a Trustee and we welcome candidates from diverse backgrounds. Above all we encourage diversity of thought.

We are looking for a team player who wants to work closely with the other Trustees, and with the management team, to help move the charity forward. This will mean also setting and agreeing the strategy to help the charity achieve our stated goals. Fundamentally we are looking to help us transform our fund-raising level by at least a factor of 3 and this Trustee will be key to helping us make this happen.

This is a voluntary position and unremunerated, although reasonable expenses will be paid.

The time commitment varies and is approximately one day per month. Trustees are expected to attend four board meetings, a strategy meeting and the AGM per year. These are held either on-line, in London or in Sheffield, where Tinnitus UK is based. Meetings are held midweek.

### The Charity

- Tinnitus UK is the only national charity specialising in Tinnitus support and their vision is a world where no one suffers from Tinnitus.
- Currently 1:7 people in the UK suffer from Tinnitus.
- There is a goal to fund research to find a cure
- Tinnitus UK supports over 1 million people a year with tinnitus via a manned helpline, website, chat bot, national support group network and other touchpoints.
- With current revenues of under £1m and a small staff team based in Sheffield, Tinnitus UK have ambitious plans to shape future research into Tinnitus and ensure everyone knows what Tinnitus is, what to do about it and how to prevent it.
- The goal is to achieve a diversified approach to fundraising, generating voluntary income from individual donors, companies, trusts, legacies, foundations and from statutory bodies. As well as communicate our message to as wide an audience as possible.
